DESCRIPTION

This two-day workshop helps educators develop high quality project-based learning units for their classrooms. Participants will learn how to create an overall project design that includes an engaging driving question, authentic audience and products, learning targets and outcomes, and appropriate level of voice and choice. Participants will also learn about how to design assessment for the project and ensure tight alignment to standards and learning outcomes. Participants will experience a variety of PBL practices in action throughout the workshop, and will leave with a project plan for the classroom.
