POSITION SUMMARY:

Middle School students are required to take a full year performing arts course in Grades 6-8 and may choose between Strings Orchestra, Band, Vocal & Modern Music, and Theater. Interest in the Theater program has exceeded capacity, so it is our desire to expand the number of sections offered in this program while maintaining the high quality of the program. Therefore, SAS is seeking candidates who can teach four or five sections of Vocal & Modern Music (required) and one or two sections of Theater (preferred).

The Vocal and Modern Music program begins in grade 6 with an introduction to guitar, keyboard, vocal ensemble, and beginning composition. Students in grade 7 specialize in guitar or piano and continue to develop their composition and vocal skills with a greater emphasis on individual vocals. Grade 8 students continue their instrumental specialization with an emphasis on composition and performance. The culminating project for the program is the production of a class album that is made available on iTunes, Spotify, and other similar platforms. These performances are recorded in our professionally equipped recording studio.
